


FRESHLY SQUEEZED


DUO DESTINO PLAY FLAMENCO FUSION

Talk & Film: Naval & Secret Forces in Dartmouth 1939-45

Friday 8 May 5.30pm

After France fell, Coastal Forces defended convoys with fast, armed boats against German E-boats and submarines. From 1942–45, the 15th Flotilla ran secret missions to Brittany, while the 23rd Flotilla was manned by the Free French barracked in Kingswear. All units were ably supported by WRNS at Dartmouth Coastal Forces HQ HMS Cicala, at what was the Royal Dart Hotel in Kingswear.



Memories of working at Philip & Son – A Maritime Legend

Friday 13 November 5.30pm

A talk and documentary film that records the memories of some of those who worked for Philip & Son over the last century. Based at Noss and Sandquay on the River Dart, Philip & Son built world-class ships and boats. Renowned for tugs and lightships after WWI, they produced over 200 vessels for the MOD in WWII, crucial to Coastal Forces operations. Models of some of the ships will be displayed.
