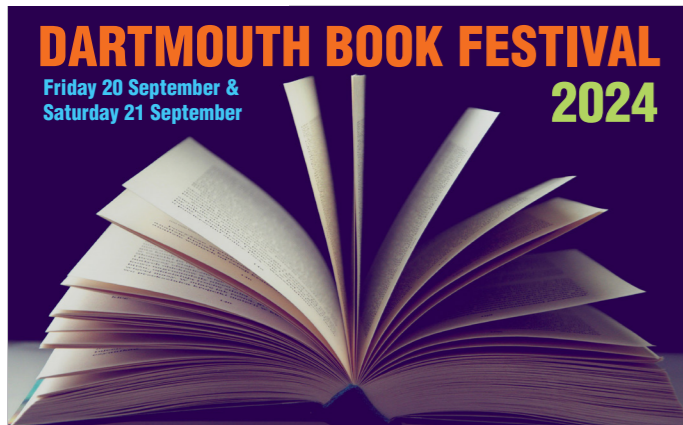

Jonathan Dimbleby will be talking about his new book, 'Endgame 1944: How Stalin Won the War', and our new patron, John Suchet will be interviewing him.

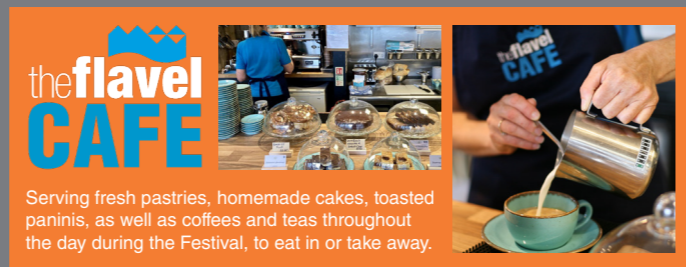
