

## **The Fisher Theatre Art Auction Sunday, 16<sup>th</sup> March 2025**

**The auction will start at 2pm in the theatre auditorium. Viewing will be at the times advertised at the theatre and on its website, from Monday 10<sup>th</sup> – Saturday 15<sup>th</sup> and on Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> from 11am until 1.45pm. On Sunday, the bar will be open and food will be available.**

**Please register your name and address before the auction. You will be given a number, to use when you bid and your name will not be called out. When you bid, the sum you offer, subject to the reserve, is the total price. There is no buyer's premium, VAT or any other charge.**

**Please note that payments cannot be taken during the auction. Afterwards, please pay for your pictures at the box office by debit card. We regret that credit card payments cannot be taken. Once you have paid, please go to the gallery and show your receipt, where you will be given the art you have bought. Bubble wrap will be provided.**

### **Conditions of Sale**

1. The Purchaser will be the highest bidder. If an event occurs (dispute) between two or more bidders as to which is the Purchaser, the Auctioneer shall either declare the Purchaser or decide immediately to re-offer the disputed Lot for sale. The auctioneer reserves the right to refuse bidding at any time, and to determine the amount to be increased with each bidding.
2. The Vendors reserve the right to place a reserve on any Lot or Lots. The reserve price for each lot is stated in the catalogue or, if lower, as advised by the Auctioneer and, though a lower price may be accepted as a bid, the lot will not be sold for less than the reserve.
3. The Purchaser will be required to give their name and address in writing when registering to bid at the sale and to pay the whole purchase money at the close of the sale. Commission bids can be taken in advance, by filling in the form available on the website or at the Theatre.
4. Each Lot shall be expressly at the risk of the Purchaser at the fall of the hammer.
5. No Lots can be removed from the sale premises until paid for.
6. **Debit card payment only** can be taken at the end of the sale and not before. There is no VAT or buyer's premium. The price to be paid for each lot will be the bid accepted by the Auctioneer, with no additional fee.
7. All descriptions and statements contained in this catalogue as to any Lot are made without responsibility on the part of the Promoters, Auctioneer or the Vendors. No such statement or description as to any Lot is to be relied on as a statement or representation of fact.
