A Journey Through Kidderminster's Town Hall Podcasts



We have recorded a special series of podcasts capturing treasured memories and the rich history of the building which we published during Heritage week. Links to them are now available via our website and social media platforms. Our guests were:

- Mike Loftus, a local historian who is very interested in industrial regeneration. He talked to us about the origins of the Town Hall which was an anchor for the development of Kidderminster as a major industrial town.
- Gay Hill, local historian and key member of our research team. Gay talked about some of the most famous visitors to the Town Hall over the decades including three Prime Ministers, three Royals, and three Suffrage meetings.
- Rose Bishop, who reflected on her tenure as Mayor of Kidderminster (2015/16) the year Kidderminster Town Council was first formed.
- Councillor Kevin Gale, an elected member of Wyre Forest District Council and former Kidderminster Town Councillor. Kevin talked about his year as Mayor of Kidderminster (2022/23), a year full of significant local, regional and national events.
- Tim Morris, who has been Kidderminster Town Hall's organist for an incredible 45 years. Tim
 chatted to us about the history of the William Hill organ at the Town Hall.
- Richard Clarke, Contracts Manager for Speller Metcalfe, who took possession of Kidderminster Town Hall on 8 January 2024. Speaking with us in January 2025 at the halfway point of the project, Richard talked about the progress of the transformation works and his experience leading several hard hat tours of the site for interested parties.
