Welcome

Thank you for your interest in choosing The Regal for your school trip. Our three auditoriums are available for hire, each equipped to meet the size of your class. All of our screens have state of the art laser projectors and surround sound, so every screen will offer you the 'big screen experience', but the space is more intimate in some of our smaller screens.

The pricing in this guide acts as a guideline for your booking, we are happy to produce a bespoke quote for your hire if you provide further detail of what you need.

Our Auditoriums

Regal 1	180 seats
Regal 2	82 seats
Regal 3	55 seats

All auditoriums have two additional wheelchair bays.

Regal 1 is our largest auditorium, perfect for year group trips and offers the ultimate big screen experience. Regal 2, our second-largest screen, still provides an excellent viewing experience within a smaller space. Regal 3 is our smallest auditorium, perfectly suited for individual classes within an intimate space.

Films



We have a catalogue of films available which are included in the hire price. If you require a film not within our catalogue, an additional fee will be added to cover the costs of sourcing the film. We will provide a bespoke quote for this.

Price

All tickets are priced at £5 per student, and for every 10 children, you can bring one teacher or helper for free. Please be aware that there is a minimum expenditure of £150. Additional teachers and helpers will be priced at £5 each.

These prices apply to weekdays during term time before 1pm. If you need a different time, please inform us, and we can offer a bespoke price.

Food & Drink

Enhance your school trip experience by adding a Combo to your ticket price! If you're interested in including combos in your booking, send us a pre-order, and we'll have everything prepared for your arrival to avoid queuing. If you need more details about other catering options, please feel free to ask.



For Primary School's we recommend a Kids Combo, which includes a kid's size popcorn, and either a fruit shoot, water, or kids size fizzy. Add a Kids Combo to your Ticket price for just £3.25 (£8.25 total admission price per student).

For Secondary School's we recommend a Regular Combo, which includes a regular size popcorn and either a regular fizzy or regular slushy. Add a Regular Combo to your Ticket price for just £5.75 (£10.75 total admission price per student).

Terms & Conditions

These terms and conditions are produced to work in conjunction with our main terms and conditions which will need to be adhered to when hiring a screen.

Payment

You will be required to pay a deposit of 10% or £100 whichever greater to secure your booking. The remaining balance will need to be paid up to 14 days prior to your school trip. This will be invoiced to you by Stowmarket Town Council. If you have a purchase order please let us know.

Cancellation

Should you need to cancel your hire, please inform the management team as soon as possible. If you have chosen a film which we were required to source away from our catalogue of films, you may be charged.

Food & Drink

Only food & drink (including alcohol) purchased at The Regal/The 1936 Café Bar may be consumed within the venue, with the exception of bottled water. Glass is not permitted in any of the auditoriums.

You must observe the licensing regulations at The Regal/The 1936 Café Bar concerning the sale and consumption of alcoholic drinks. We reserve the right to require you to prove your age with appropriate photographic ID if you are attempting to purchase an alcohol drink. If you are unable to prove your age you will not be able to buy an alcoholic drink. We reserve the right to ask for such proof at any time you are on the premises. We also reserve the right to refuse the sale of alcohol in order to align with and promote the four licensing objectives.

Behaviour

We reserve the right to refuse admission or require you to leave the premises without a refund if you:

- Behave in an anti-social or threatening manner
- Put the safety of our customers, employees or property at risk
- Bring a camera or recording equipment of any kind into the cinema
- Otherwise breach these terms.

Terms & Conditions continued

Piracy

Mobile phones must be switched off or put on silent mode before you enter the auditorium. It is a serious criminal offence to copy to attempt to copy any film or other copyright material exhibited in any part of the cinema, punishable on conviction with an unlimited fine and imprisonment of up to a maximum of ten years. You are not permitted to bring cameras or any recording equipment of any kind into the cinema.

Film Certifications

Entry to films and events is restricted by the classification given by the British Board of Film Classification or others. We are required to refuse admission to anyone who is below the minimum age required by the relevant classification:

- Anyone can be admitted to films classified as U or PG.
- Children under 12 can be admitted to films classified as 12A but only if accompanied by an adult (someone over the age of 18).
- Nobody under the age of 15 can be admitted to films classified as 15.
- Nobody under the age of 18 can be admitted to films classified as 18.
- Children under the age of 8 must be accompanied by an adult at all times.
- It is advised that children under the age of 10 are accompanied at all times.
- Children under the age of 3 can attend films for free providing they sit on the lap for the entire screening (do not take up a seat) and they are removed from the auditorium should they cause a disturbance to other customers. Children under 3 can only attend films rated U, PG or 12A.

We reserve the right to require you to prove your age with appropriate photographic ID if you are to a 12A, 15 or 18 film or purchasing an alcoholic drink. If you are unable to prove your age you will not be able to watch the film or buy an alcoholic drink. We reserve the right to ask for such proof at any time you are on the remises.
