WHAT IS RDDC?

The Redbridge Drama and Dance Course offers a 2 year extended diploma in creative and performing arts. Based in East London, we are conveniently located to multiple transport links.

THE COURSE

In partnership with RSL (Rockschool Ltd) we deliver the Level 3 Diploma in Creative and Performing Arts (One year course) which is a high-quality equivalent of two A levels, as well as the extended Level 3 Diploma (Two year course) which is a high-quality equivalent of three A levels. Learners will follow the Musical Theatre pathway. A key term in musical theatre training is to be a *"triple threat perfomer"* which means the ability to act, sing and dance to a high standard. This pathway is specifically designed to develop the skills and experience to build a career in Musical Theatre.

The RSL Diploma follows an holistic curriculum of dance, singing and acting techniques across three terms, with in-house assessments, termly performances, touring opportunities and culminating in an RDDC showcase. Our unique syllabus includes twice weekly group fitness sessions, weekly workshops from industry professionals and one to one singing lessons.

The REDBRIDGE DRAMA & DANCE COURSE is committed to developing students' potential within the creative industries, enabling students to hone their own strengths and skills in readiness for their future, whether that is in further education, apprenticeships or employment. We believe that the individual training is invaluable therefore we take a limited number of students per year to allow for one to one personalised training. Subjects studied include:

FACILITY

Redbridge Drama Centre is located in South Woodford and is a centre for creating, performing and watching theatre for all ages. It is recognised by Arts Council England as a National Portfolio Organisation and works with schools and the community to provide creative opportunities to Redbridge children and young people and the wider community. Its central location means it is easily accessible by tube (central line) and public transport.

Facilities include five studios, including two theatres, equipped with vinyl flooring, air conditioning and sound systems, plus dressing room, video editing suite and on site cafe. Our PIRKO Studio is newly refurbished with a mirrored wall and barre bar. Our CIRCUS studio is equipped with trapeze and ropes for Aerial skills workshops. Our sister venue - Kenneth More Theatre, seats 350 and is located in the centre of Ilford.
