TICKETS

Ticket prices vary per performance.

- All ticket prices include a £1.50 Theatre Maintenance Levy, which is reinvested into maintaining the Theatre building.

- Concession tickets are available for those who are registered disabled, over 60's and students. We may ask for proof of eligibility.

- Those under 12 months do not need a ticket.

- Our e-ticket QR code will arrive in your confirmation email which we will scan on entry. Simply show them on your phone or print them off before you arrive.


