As part of the remembrance and reflection ceremonies taking place during Holocaust Memorial Week, Redbridge Drama Centre are proud to present a short play written by Lenna Rosenberg, former head teacher of Clore Tikva School, depicting the journey of a Jewish Child Survivor who endures the Warsaw Ghetto.

The play was inspired by visits to the Ghetto Fighters Museum in Northern Israel, to the Yad Vashem World Holocaust Memorial Centre in Jerusalem, and Auschwitz. This complex subject motivates pupils to deal with their emotional development and further their understanding of this tragic period through poetry, art and drama workshops. Pupils will be encouraged to create scenarios and interpret their feelings in a creative form led by experienced workshop facilitator David Alexander. Virginia Woolf: Killing the Angel
